

# Interacting with the Tee-to-Green Scoring System

This system receives member input rounds and displays the results of weekly scoring. There is a repetitive sequence of time periods when member input is accepted. Two types of input are used: member rounds and the selected 3 holes used for scoring a week's play. Member rounds for a playdate can be submitted in the afternoon of the playdate through the end of the following Wednesday. On the next day (the next playdate) drawings are held to select a par 3, two par 4s and a par 5 hole to be used for scoring the prior week. Those selected 4 holes must be entered into the system for the prior week's scoring to occur. When (and ONLY when) those holes are entered can members start entering the current playdate's rounds. Below is an example timeline...

If your submission does not occur in the compatible period, it will be rejected – to be entered by you again. If it contains an error, it will be rejected. You should get confirmation of either acceptance or rejection.

You will be using Email for your submissions. ONLY Email from registered members will be examined. All others will be rejected. Members from last year are considered registered. New members must provide their Email address to a club officer to be able to submit.

This system is hosted by Google on their servers (computers). Because many people use their services, their servers are heavily used. They limit computer time for processing our system's submissions. To comply with these limitations, the accumulated Email messages sent by you will be processed on an hourly basis. Depending on when in an hour you make a submission, it may be up to one hour before you get a return Email. Likewise, the results of that submission may not appear for the same period.
